

Scope of Work

Crane Services

This contract consists of Crane services that the City will assign to the Contractor based on the City's needs within the City of Bushnell service area.

The proposed Work is generally described as follows:

- Contractor will provide Certified Crane Operator.
- Contractor will provide designated Certified Riggers to rig (hook up loads) tag lines and (if necessary) and unhook the load per OSHA requirements.
- Contractor will provide the counter weights along with transportation for any and all counter weights required for each lift at each job location.
- Bid price shall incorporate any and all surcharge such as any increasing costs associated with Governmental, Entity Specific and Contractual Regulations. I.E. cost associated with Safety and Training Costs as well as OSHA, MSHA, FDOT, Port Authority, NCCCCO and the EPA.
- All operated cranes include labor, fuel, maintenance, insurance and basic rigging accessories.
- Basic rigging accessories included with operated crane: (4) 1" shackles, (4) 1/2" shackles, (4) 20' x 4" mat nylon slings, (4) 20' round polyester slings, (4) 10' x 5/8" steel chokers with hooks.

City Responsibilities:

- If applicable, City will provide aviation, street, and lane closures, maintenance of traffic and all special work permits.
- Provide stable compact ground access without delay and free of obstructions for assembly/disassembly as well as compacted road for the crane to travel and work.

Bond Requirements:

- Bid Bond: Bid security equal to five percent (5%) of the total bid must accompany each bid. (This will be uploaded in electronic form only in the section labeled "Bid Bond." The original document will be maintained by the Contractor unless requested to produce by the City.)

Liquidated Damages:

- If the Contractor is scheduled to be at a project site at a predetermined time and does not show without notifying the City Manager 24 hrs. before time, the City shall have the right to deduct liquidated damages from any money in its hands, otherwise due, or to become due, to the Contractor, or to initiate applicable dispute resolution procedures and to recover liquidated damages for non-performance of this Contract within the time stipulated.
- Nothing in this section is intended to limit the right to obtain injunctive relief or any and all relief as may be appropriate. Permission allowing the Contractor to continue and finish any part of the work after the time fixed for its completion or after the date to which the time for completion may have been extended shall in no way operate as a waiver on the part of the City of any of its rights under this Agreement

Working Hours:

- **Contractor's time shall start when Contractor arrives at designated project site.**
- **Monday thru Friday 8:00am to 4:00pm.**
